## **!!NATIONAL ARCHIVES GOING ONLY 9-5!!**

This regulation will affect individuals who use our archival research rooms in the National Archives building and National Archives at College Park facility, and individuals who visit the National Archives Experience and the Rotunda exhibits in the National Archives Building. This interim final rule would change the research room hours to 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. on weekdays, eliminating evening and Saturday hours.

Also under the rule public hours for exhibit areas in the National Archives Building from the day after Labor Day through March 14, would be 10 a.m. to 5:30 p.m., and March 15 through Labor Day, 10 a.m. to 7 p.m. extending hours in the spring and reducing hours in the summer. The building would now be closed on Thanksgiving Day as well as December 25.
