## ARPA Violators Sentenced

On March 11, 2007, three men were apprehended after metal-detecting and digging up relics on the Spotsylvania Battlefield in Virginia. Over 460 holes were found and documented on and around park earthworks where the men had been seen digging, making the incident one of the most destructive ARPA violations in NPS Northeast Region history.

All three men appeared in court and either pled or was found guilty and sentenced. In June, Vincent Williams, 37, pled guilty and was ordered to pay \$1,400 in restitution. In September, Fenton Terembes, Jr., 28, was sentenced to twenty-four months in jail, followed by a year of supervised probation, and ordered to pay \$28,600 in restitution following his guilty plea to a felony ARPA charge. In November, Jeremy Burroughs, 30, was sentenced to 18 months in jail, followed by three years of supervised probation, and ordered to pay \$28,600 in restitution. This was Burroughs’ second felony ARPA violation; his previous conviction was in 1998.

All three men forfeited their equipment and the seized artifacts. The park also recovered a CSA belt buckle valued at \$3,300 that had been removed from the park by Terembes earlier in the same week.
