## THE MID-19<sup>TH</sup> CENTURY KIELKOPF HOUSE IN ODESSA, DELAWARE



Patrick O'Neill is the President of the Archaeological Society of Virginia. In 2000, he worked on a project for the Delaware Department of Transportation for a turn-lane in the National Register District of Odessa, Delaware. The investigations found the remains of the razed Kielkopf house, outbuildings, privy, and other detailed information usually reserved for only standing structures.
